With more than 480 illustrations, this is the most comprehensive publication to date on one of the greatest painters of the twentieth and early twenty-first centuries, Lucian Freud.



Picasso, toros y toreros





The original edition, published by Abrams, has been out of print for many years, and is republished now in a glorious slip-cased edition, printed in nine colours.




Marina Abramović: Writings 1960-2014




Roberto Burle Marx Lectures





Bright Black World Todd Hido




Rirkrit Tiravanija

It follows onestar press's inaugural tray project by Lawrence Weiner.





Architect, Designer, Entrepreneur


