In 1978, she jointly founded the Camara Obscura School of Art,a photography, video, film and digital art school in Tel Aviv. Ten years later she moved to New York.

In November 2007, the America-Israel Cultural Foundation (AICF) presented Rovner with the Aviv Award in New York in recognition of her artistic achievements. She also received a Doctor Honoris Causa in Philosophy from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in June 2008. Rovner's work combines photography, video, film and digital art.
